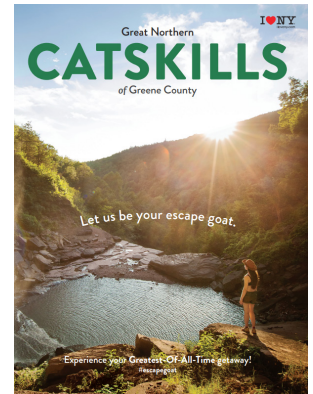
Catskill Mountain Foundation Begins 21st Year
