Online Shopping Drives Sales in Greene County Over \$1 Billion for 2021



Beginning In 2019, taxes on internet purchases are paid to the state the goods are shipped to (not where they came from). This, combined with changes to shopping habits during the pandemic set a new record last year - a strong indicator of our economic growth. NYS Payments to the County in 2021

surpassed 2020 by over \$6.5 million. This is the 12th year in a row that sales tax revenue has risen over the previous year. Commitment to fiscal responsibility by the Greene County Legislature continues to keep property taxes among the lowest in the state.

Greene County Unemployment Rate Falls to 3%



According to the preliminary report issued by the NYS Department of Labor on unemployment rates for December 2021, the County's jobless rate fell by 3.2% from 6.2% during December 2020. With many businesses seeking to hire, attracting

additional workforce to Greene County is a high priority. The unemployment rate in Greene County is lower than 29 other New York counties, and the State-wide average is 6.2%. Village of Hunter Receives \$1.97 Million NYS Grant



This award enables the Village of Hunter to relocate its fire station 0.15-miles west of its current site taking it outside of the regulatory floodway and the 100-

year and 500-year flood hazard areas of the Schoharie Creek. The existing fire station and back building will be demolished and replaced with a municipal park with streamside access. Currently, the existing fire station becomes inaccessible during even moderate flood events due to the undersized bridge. Relocation of the firehouse will allow for the expansion of the bridge and greatly alleviate flooding throughout the village.

NYSERDA Incentives for Carbon **Neutral Economic Development**



Buildings а significant are contributor to greenhouse gas emissions, primarily carbon. NYSERDA offers incentives to

support economic development projects across New York State that are designed to carbon neutral net zero energy performance. The Catskill Gateway Carbon Neutral Project in the Village of Catskill was recently awarded \$1,914,059 from NYS to include the installation of energy efficient systems for two of the three buildings at 329 and 331 Main Street, which will serve as a model for how sustainable energy can be used in renovation projects. Once complete, this project will demonstrate a practical adaptation of renewable energy for historic redevelopment.
