Economic Indicators for Greene County

The August 2022 Capital Region Labor Analysis indicated a surge in the regional labor market with rising job figures and declining unemployment rates. Greene County outpaced the region's unemployment rate change from 4.8% in August 2021 to 3.8%, adding 300 jobs to the county's employment base. Greene County netted a positive contribution to workforce figures when comparing to total unemployment claims in August of last year.

Greene County continues to trend positive sales tax growth. A year-over-year analysis showed a 15% increase in sales tax receipts, indicating heavier summer spending by seasonal consumers in 2022. If end of year projections meet expectations, Greene County would benefit from another year of positive sales tax growth, continuing the 13+ year long trend.
