<u>Advocates</u>: For Youth Services in Greene County.


<u>Conducts</u>: Ongoing research to determine the changing needs of our youth.

The Youth Bureau has a prevention program that works with at risk youth and their families to ensure that the family is supported, stays together, and that the child/children remain at home and in their community. This is done through periodic reality checks while improving the quality of communication and decision making within the client household.


