WHEREAS, Section 2541 of Chapter 429 of the Laws of 1992 requires the MUNICIPALITY to provide Early Intervention Services to infants and toddlers suspected of developmental delay or disability or with a confirmed disability who are residing in Greene County; and

WHEREAS, New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Early Intervention requires that all Early Intervention Service Providers enter into a provider agreement with the New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Early Intervention; and

WHEREAS, Greene County Public Health Nursing Service is a provider of Service Coordination and Skilled Nursing Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Greene County Legislature be authorized to execute an Early Intervention Provider agreement, subject to approval as to form by the County Attorney, between Greene County Public Health Nursing Service and New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Early Intervention. This agreement will be effective for a five (5) year term (April 1st, 2013 – March 31st, 2018).
