

RESPIRATOR PROGRAM ELEMENTS

PROPER RESPIRATOR SELECTION

• ANNUAL PROGRAM EVALUATION

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERIOR STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTERS – 1910.134(G)(4) (2 IN/2 OUT)

- AT LEAST TWO FIREFIGHTERS ENTER THE IDLH ATMOSPHERE AND REMAIN IN VISUAL OR VOICE CONTACT WITH ONE ANOTHER AT ALL TIMES;
- AT LEAST TWO FIREFIGHTERS ARE LOCATED OUTSIDE THE IDLH ATMOSPHERE;
- RADIO COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE INTERIOR TEAM AND EXTERIOR RESCUE TEAM IS ALLOWED. HOWEVER THE INTERIOR TEAM MUST MAINTAIN VISUAL OR VOICE COMMUNICATION BETWEEN TEAM MEMBERS.

ALL FIREFIGHTERS ENGAGED IN INTERIOR STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTING USE SCBAS.

FIRE BRIGADE STANDARD 1910.156(B)(1)

Organizational statement. The employer shall prepare and maintain a statement or written policy which establishes the:

- Existence of a fire brigade;
- Basic organizational structure;
- Type, amount, and frequency of training to be provided to fire brigade members;
- Expected number of members in the fire brigade &
- Functions that the fire brigade is to perform at the workplace.

ORGANIZATIONAL STATEMENT...

- IF A DEPARTMENT HAS BY-LAWS AND SOPS/SOGS THAT CONTAIN THIS INFORMATION THAT IS ACCEPTABLE
- THE ORGANIZATIONAL STATEMENT DOES NOT HAVE TO BE ONE INCLUSIVE DOCUMENT.




ANNUAL TRAINING

- TRAINING PROGRAMS SHALL BE DESIGNED TO ADDRESS ANNUALLY THE PROFICIENCY OF EACH MEMBER'S KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES AS IT RELATES TO THAT MEMBER'S EXPECTED ASSIGNMENT; AND
- INTERIOR STRUCTURAL FIRE FIGHTERS SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH TRAINING AT LEAST <u>QUARTERLY</u>.
