

2019 Early Voting Communication Plan

2019 General Election

For the 2019 November general election, you can vote in person before Election Day.

What is Early Voting?

For the first time in New York State, voters can vote in-person before Election Day.

Who can vote early?

All registered voters can vote early.

When can I vote early?

Early Voting in New York State will begin prior to the November 5th General Election. The early voting period will be from Saturday, October 26, 2019 through Sunday, November 3, 2019.

Day and hours as follows:

Saturday, October 26th and Sunday, October 27th: 9am to 2pm

Monday, October 28th and Wednesday, October 30th: 12pm to 8pm

Tuesday, October 29th, Thursday, October 31st and Friday, November 1st: 9am to 5pm

Saturday, November 2nd and Sunday, November 3rd: 9am to 2pm

Where can I vote early?

Greene County's early voting site is located at 411 Main St, Suite 430, Catskill, NY

How will I vote during early voting?

Voting during early voting is the same as voting on Election Day. When you get to the early voting site, you will check in to vote, receive your ballot and vote as any other election.

There will be instructions available at the early voting site to familiarize you with the ballot. There will also be a notice to voter and bill of rights. You may ask an election inspector to explain how to vote, or if you need any assistance.

If you vote during the early voting period, you are not eligible to vote on Election Day.
