### EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2

**WHEREAS**, on March 15, 2020, Executive Order No.1 of 2020 declared a Local State of Emergency in the County of Greene due to the threat to public safety produced by the effects of the ongoing COVID-19 Virus; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the powers vested in me as Chairman of the Greene County Legislature pursuant to New York Executive Law §24, which authorizes me to promulgate Local Emergency Orders upon a finding that the public safety is imperiled by the event of a public emergency or in the event of reasonable apprehension or immediate danger thereof, to protect life and property and to bring an emergency situation under control; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, by the power vested in me as the Chairman of the Greene County Legislature, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

#### Section 1. Closings.

With regard to all Senior Citizen Centers operated by Greene County, it is the intent of this Order to close all such facilities to the public, effective immediately. Greene County employees may enter Senior citizen Centers during the pendency of this Local Emergency Order.

Meals on Wheels programs will continue to operate and senior citizens may pick up meals from their local Senior Citizen Center, to be consumed elsewhere.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Local Emergency Order shall take effect immediately.

Section 3. Duration of Local Emergency Order

The Local Emergency Order declared in Section 1 shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless soon extended or rescinded. This Order may be extended for a additional periods, each period not to exceed five (5) days, during the pendency of the Local State of Emergency.
