**Project Description:** 

The (DEC) is proposing a renewal and Department Initiated Modification (DIM) to the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES)

Permit NY0263214, pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 750-1.18, and 750-1.19, the Priority Ranking System known as New York State's Environmental Benefit Permit Strategy (EBPS), and the Drinking Water Source Protection program for the Mohawk Watershed. The facility receives flow from domestic users. The treatment plant provides secondary treatment for a design flow of 0.026 MGD. Treated sanitary wastewater is discharged via Outfall 001 to the Batavia Kill, a class C(T) water. The sewage collection system consists of separate sewers. Treatment includes: settling tank, sand filtration, microfiltration, and UV disinfection. Sludge is pumped and hauled to a landfill. The following changes to the permit are proposed: low priority mercury minimization requirements were added; and, modified the reporting of ammonia (NH3) to ammonia as N. A new five-year term is proposed. The permit includes updated forms and the latest general conditions. # **Negative Declaration**

Greene County - The Greene County Legislature, as lead agency, has determined that the proposed Demolition of the Greene County Jail Complex will not have a significant adverse environmental impact. The action involves the complete demolition and removal of the Greene County Jail Complex structures, to include the Jail, Sheriff's Office, and D-Block structures; to include disconnection of utility services to the site, including electricity, natural gas, public water and sewer connections; to include abatement of identified hazardous asbestos containing materials and lead paint; to include site stabilization improvements, including back-filling excavations for foundation removal, site grading, drainage controls, parking improvements and access; to include public safety controls for the adjoining Courthouse facilities, including security fencing.
