COVID-19 UPDATE

(Johns Hopkins, CDC, NYSDOH)

March 23, 2020

- ▶ Cases worldwide total 372,572 / total deaths 16,313 / total recovered 101,371
- ▶ Cases in 146 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ Expanded testing has been approved, including NYS Wadsworth Lab, Labcorp, & Quest that we work closely with.
- ▶ USA: 41,569 cases / 504 deaths
- ▶ Expanded testing has been approved in New York State, including NYS Wadsworth Lab, Labcorp, & Quest
- ▶ New York State has 15,168 cases / 122 deaths
- ▶ Greene County has 6 positive cases located in Windham, Hunter, and Cairo. 26 individuals are being self-monitored for possible exposure.

Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. We have no resulting hospitalizations for our 6 positive cases and all are convalescing at home. Currently testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure. ***It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.***
