COVID-19 UPDATE

(Johns Hopkins, CDC, NYSDOH)

March 25, 2020

- ▶ Cases worldwide total 445,753 / total deaths 19,766 / total recovered 112,037
- ▶ Cases in 196 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.
- ▶ USA: 59,909 cases / 791 deaths
- ▶ New York State has 30,811 cases / 271 deaths
- ▶ Greene County has 8 positive cases located in Windham, Durham, Greenville, Hunter, and Cairo. 32 individuals are being self-monitored for possible exposure.

Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. We have 8 positive cases and most are convalescing at home with one hospitalization. Currently, testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure.
