COVID-19 UPDATE

(Johns Hopkins, CDC, NYSDOH)

March 31, 2020

- ▶ Cases worldwide total 837,016 / total deaths 41,238 / total recovered 174,502
- ▶ Cases in 202 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.
- ▶ USA: 176,518 cases / 3,431 deaths
- ▶ New York State has 75,795 cases / 1,550 deaths
- ▶ Greene County has 20 accumulative positive cases located in Windham, Durham, Greenville, Hunter, Cairo, Catskill, Athens and Coxsackie. 6 cases that tested positive have been cleared and given the status of "discharged", leaving 14 active positive cases. Currently 88 individuals are being self-monitored for possible exposure with 22 additional cases that have been released from quarantine status.

Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. We have 20 accumulative positive cases and most are convalescing at home with 2 hospitalizations. Currently, testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure.
