COVID-19 UPDATE (Johns Hopkins, CDC, NYSDOH)

April 14, 2020

- ▶ Cases worldwide total 1,980,793 / total deaths 125,018 / total recovered 465,898
- ▶ Cases in 210 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.
- ▶ USA: 603,059 cases / 25,143 deaths
- ▶ New York State has 202,208 cases / 10,834 deaths
- ▶ Greene County has 80 accumulative positive cases located in Windham, Durham, Greenville, Hunter, Cairo, Catskill, Athens, Coxsackie and Halcott.

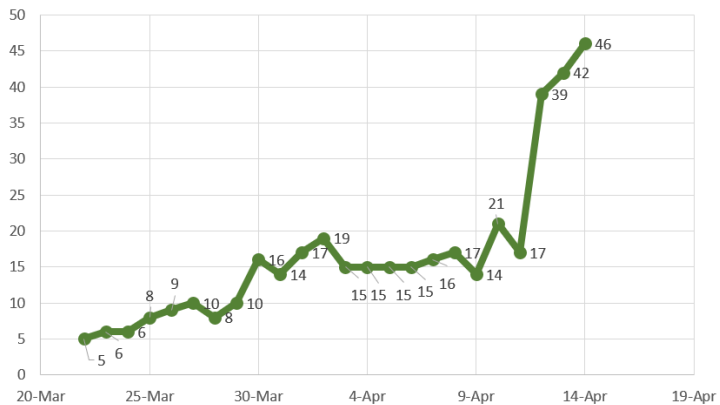
Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. Currently, testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure.
