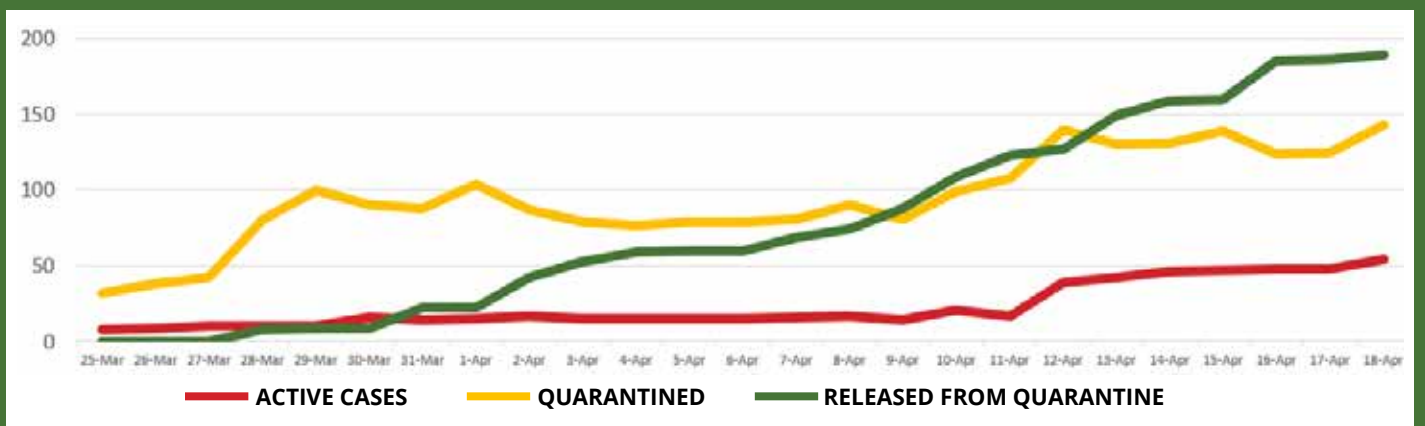
- ▶ Cases worldwide total 2,313,897 / total deaths 159,033 / total recovered 591,297
- ▶ Cases in 210 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.
- ▶ USA: 728,293 cases / 38,244 deaths
- ▶ New York State has 241,041 cases / 17,670 deaths
- ▶ Three Greene County residents have died due to causes related to Covid-19, all three were senior citizens who had pre-existing medical conditions.
- ▶ Greene County has 96 accumulative positive cases located in Windham, Durham, Greenville, Hunter, Cairo, Catskill, Athens, Coxsackie, Halcott and New Baltimore.

Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. Currently, testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure.
