COVID-19 UPDATE

April 4, 2020

(Johns Hopkins, CDC, NYSDOH)

- ▶ Cases worldwide total 1,159,953 / total deaths 62,399 / total recovered 241,630
- ▶ Cases in 205 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.
- ▶ USA: 293,142 cases / 7,885 deaths
- ▶ New York State has 113,704 cases / 3,565 deaths
- ▶ Greene County has 27 accumulative positive cases located in Windham, Durham, Greenville, Hunter, Cairo, Catskill, Athens, Coxsackie and Halcott.
 - 12 cases that tested positive have been cleared and given the status of "discharged", leaving 15 active positive cases.
 - Currently 77 individuals are being self-monitored for possible exposure with 6 additional cases that have been released from quarantine status.

Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. We have 27 accumulative positive cases and most are convalescing at home with 4 hospitalizations. Currently, testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure.
