COVID-19 UPDATE

April 7, 2020

(Johns Hopkins, CDC, NYSDOH)

- ▶ Cases worldwide total 1,414,710 / total deaths 81,248 / total recovered 301,304
- ▶ Cases in 209 countries
- ▶ Sustained community spread with level 2 & 3 travel warnings
- ▶ Travelers to these areas are at increased risk of exposure
- ▶ It is important to note that at this time due to limited testing capability, the number of positive cases may not fully reflect current illness.
- ▶ USA: 388,757 cases / 12,400 deaths
- ▶ New York State has 138,836 cases / 5,489 deaths
- ▶ Greene County has 28 accumulative positive cases located in Windham, Durham, Greenville, Hunter, Cairo, Catskill, Athens, Coxsackie and Halcott.

Greene County Public Health is taking every measure to manage exposure to County residents including monitoring people post travel and those that have been exposed. We are monitoring people in both precautionary and mandatory quarantine daily. Currently, testing is limited to those with symptoms and positive exposure.
