




## EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY ORDER No. 6

On March 15, 2020 a State of Emergency had been declared in Greene County due to the threat to public safety produced by the effects of the ongoing COVID-19 Virus, affecting all portions of the jurisdiction.

On May 18, 2020 Greene County enacted Emergency Order No. 6, pre-approved by NYSDOH, permitting Greene County to extend contracts for the transportation of children with severe physical disabilities, notwithstanding the provisions of General Municipal Law §103.

By the powers vested in me as Chairman of the Greene County Legislature and pursuant to New York Executive Law §24, I hereby extend Greene County Emergency Order No. 6 for an additional FIVE (5) day period or until rescinded or extended by subsequent order, in order to preserve the public safety and render available assistance vital to the well-being and health of citizens of Greene County. This extension of Greene County Emergency Order No. 6 shall become effective July 12, 2020.
