

EXTENSION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

On March 15, 2020 a State of Emergency had been declared in Greene County due to the threat to public safety produced by the effects of the ongoing COVID-19 Virus, affecting all portions of the jurisdiction. Said State of Emergency Declaration is known as Greene County Executive Order No. 1 of 2020; a copy of which is attached hereto.

By the powers vested in me as Chairman of the Greene County Legislature and pursuant to New York Executive Law §24(1) I hereby extend Greene County Executive Order No. 1 for an additional period of THIRTY (30) days, or until rescinded or extended by subsequent order, in order to preserve the public safety and render available assistance vital to the well-being and health of the citizens of Greene County. This Extension of Greene County Executive Law No. 1 shall become effective October 15, 2020.

- This State of Emergency must be filed within seventy-two hours with the Clerk of the County Legislature, Greene County Clerk, Office of the Secretary of State and the State Office of Emergency Management within the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services.
- 2. Anyone who knowingly violates any emergency order is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
