



COUNTY OF GREENE

ORDER RESCINDING EMERGENCY ORDER No. 3

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, Executive Order No.1 of 2020 declared a Local State of Emergency in the County of Greene due to the threat to public safety produced by the effects of the ongoing COVID-19 Virus; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No.1 has been duly extended every THIRTY (30) day period since March 15, 2020 and remains in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me as Chairman of the Greene County Legislature pursuant to New York Executive Law §24, which authorized me to promulgate Local Emergency Orders upon a finding that the public safety is/was imperiled by the event of a public emergency or in the event of a reasonable apprehension of immediate danger thereof, to protect life and property and bring an emergency situation under control, I promulgated Emergency Order No. 3 which decreed that members of the public were required to make an appointment(s) to conduct business or otherwise transact at the Department of Motor Vehicles in Greene County, and

WHEREAS, Greene County seeks to remain consistent with and in full compliance of all of the Governor's State of New York Executive Orders relative to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

WHEREFORE, by the power vested in me as Chairman of the Greene County Legislature, **it is hereby ORDERED;**

That Emergency Order No. 3 dated March 15, 2020 is hereby rescinded.
