He is approachable, professional, and yet extremely effective as a road patrol member. He is one of our lead field Training Officers, often giving his own time to help new Deputies learn and excel. He takes great pride in helping a new employee become a well-rounded and fully prepared Deputy with Greene County. He does so much and often volunteers his own time, for the betterment of the Greene County Sheriff's Office and for the safety of the citizens of Greene County.

That is just the kind of person he is, and the kind of dad he is: a devoted father of two, with a baby on the way! He is respected by all, and deeply loved by children and animals, which speaks volumes about his temperament, philosophy and the way he lives his life.

As a K-9 Officer and drone operator, Kris is pretty much on-call all the time (but not compensated as such) and he has never failed to come in when needed. Kris also serves as a volunteer firefighter with the Medway-Grapeville Fire Company. His dedication is phenomenal, and he fully deserves to be recognized for all the work he does for the citizens of Greene County.
