FDA approves low dose hormonal birth control pill & Paragard (copper IUD)

March 1982

Family Planning relocates to Jefferson Medical Center

November 1983

Barbara Caldara, RN appointed interim Nurse/Family Planning Director

January 1984

Barbara Caldara, RN appointed Nurse/Family Planning Director

October 1988

HIV counseling and testing program became effective
