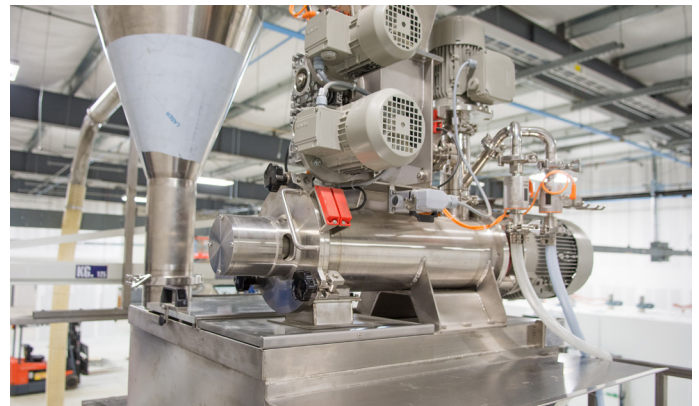

New York State Consolidated Funding Application (CFA) Now Open Thru July 28, 2023



Funding is available for job creating businesses, municipalities, and not-for-profits from 30 programs through the CFA process. Round XIII includes core capital grant and tax-credit funding combined with a wide range of programs from 10 State agencies, including \$150 million in grant funds from Empire State Development, available to projects on a continuous basis.
