#### Windham Mountain Announces Initial Resort Master Plan



Windham Mountain has presented a resort master plan to the Town Board of Windham. The presentation focused on the development of the acquired Fromm/East Side property, incorporating townhomes, single-family properties, lots, and green space. #### Downtown Revitalization Initiative Round 7 and NY Forward Round 2 Officially Announced

Communities across the state will be gearing up for another round of NYS's infamously competitive Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI) and NY Forward (NYF) programs according to an announcement made by Governor Hochul earlier this week. This announcement marks the seventh iteration of the DRI program, which was created in 2016 to catalyze revitalization efforts in each of the ten economic development regions across the State, while NYF enters its second rendition after launching in 2022. The

latter program was recently established to offer smaller, more rural downtown corridors, a chance at competing with comparable communities, each vying for a more proportionate award compared to their larger, DRI-focused, counterparts. Two Greene County communities received funding from each program within the past two years. The Village of Tannersville was awarded \$10 million in 2021 as part of the fifth round of the DRI, while most recently, the Village of Coxsackie was awarded \$4.5 million as the first-ever NY Forward awardee in the Capital Region. #### **Hull-O Farms Honored**



In 2023, Hull-O Farms was nominated by State Senator Michelle Hinchey to be added to the State Historic Business Registry. The designation was celebrated on Wednesday, July 16, 2023, with a ceremony at the farm attended by Senator Hinchey, Assemblyman Chris Tague, Greene County Sheriff Peter Kusminsky, Greene County Tourism Director

Patty Austin, Town Historian MaryLou Nahas, and members of the Durham Valley Land Trust. Senator Hinchey said that the designation is a "well-deserved honor" for Hull-O Farms, and that the farm is "a testament to the hard work and dedication of the Hull family." The farm is situated on 275 acres in the Northern Catskill Mountains and currently produces hay, corn, and all-natural meats. It also offers farm stay vacations and seasonal hunting opportunities. #### **Empire State Development Hosting DRI/NYF Forum**

NYS ESD will host an online forum for organizations seeking to apply for Downtown Revitalization Initiative and NY Forward funding on August 9th. Interested parties considering an application this year can register and receive instructions on how to join the meeting. These programs delivered \$10 million to the Village of Tannersville in 2022 and \$4.5 Million to the Village of Coxsackie in 2023. Greene County communities are urged to apply to this highly competitive process, even if they have not received awards in the past.
