



EXTENSION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION
As Amended

On May 17, 2023 a State of Emergency had been declared in Greene County due to the threat to public safety produced by the failed Federal Policy(ies) together with New York City's mismanagement and/or underestimation of the impact of inviting persons in need of temporary assistance and housing to the city, resulting in New York City planning to relocate many of said persons in need of temporary assistance and housing to the counties, outside of and nearby New York City, including Greene County.

By the powers vested in me as Chairman of the Greene County Legislature and pursuant to New York Executive Law §24(1), I hereby extend Greene County Amended Executive Order No. 1/ State of Emergency Declaration for an additional period of THIRTY (30) days, or until rescinded or extended by subsequent order, in order to preserve the public. This Extension of the amended Greene County Executive Law No. 1 shall become effective October 12, 2023.

Notes:

1. This State of Emergency must be filed within seventy-two hours with the Clerk of the County legislature, Greene County Clerk, Office of the Secretary of State and the State Office of Emergency Management within the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services.
2. Anyone who knowingly violates any emergency order is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
