WHAT IS HIV?

HIV or human immunodeficiency virus is a chronic immune system disease. HIV damages the immune system and interfered with the body's ability to fight infection & disease. It can spread through contact with infected blood, semen, or vaginal fluids.

HOW CAN I PREVENT HIV?

PrEP - pre-exposure prophylaxis

- Meant for individuals who are HIV negative
- An individual's partner may be HIV positive
- If an individual has had anal or vaginal sex in the past 6 months

TIPS FOR GETTING SCREENED FOR HIV

- CDC recommends everyone between the ages of 13 and 64 get tested for HIV at least once.
- Talk to one of our NP's about getting tested in our clinic!
- Our services are anonymous and confidential for all genders!

We offer online scheduling for in-person and telemedicine appointments!



HIV - Perinatal Transmission


- HIV can be passed to a baby during pregnancy, childbirth, and breast/chestfeeding
- The risk of transmitting HIV to your baby can be 1% or less if you:
 - Take HIV treatment as prescribed throughout pregnancy and delivery.
 - Give HIV medication to your baby 2-6 weeks after birth.

Perinatal HIV diagnoses decreased 41% from 2015 to 2019.
