- **TEEN SERVICES:** *Walk-in’s welcome every day. Teen walk in clinic every Wednesday from 3 p.m. - 6 p.m. Provides confidential reproductive health care to adolescents while encouraging participation and involvement of family members in the counseling and care of adolescents. If you bring someone with you, your confidentiality is still protected. We may not disclose information about you unless we have your consent. We are mandated child abuse reporters, so if a minor (a person under the age of 18) tells us they are being abused or neglected by their parent or guardian, we must report that to the Child Abuse Hotline. You may receive all of the services available at Greene County Family Planning whether you have discussed this with your parent/guardian or not.*

The Greene County Public Health Department provides several programs specifically for children.

- **EARLY INTERVENTION:** *The Early Intervention Program provides cost free screening evaluations and services for eligible children through age three who have developmental delays.*
- **CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS:** *The Children with Special Health Care Needs Program provides free assistance for children through age 21 in finding medical and related community services (including insurance).*
- **PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION:** *The Preschool Special Education Program provides educational services to children age 3 to 5 who have a disability that affects their learning.*

GREENE COUNTY DEPT. of SOCIAL SERVICES

- **CASE MANAGEMENT:** Social work professionals meet in the home with the parent/guardians and the child and help facilitate important community supports to families with children in distress. This may include but not limited to community assistance programs, community recreation and arts programs, treatment providers as needed by the child and school systems to coordinate educational and behavioral goals. Help families set and initiate positive life goals for their child.
- **HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED WAIVER:** Provides intensive wrap around services to children diagnosed with severe emotional disturbances between the ages of 5-17. Provides children and families with strength based individualized care coordination, respite, skill-building, intensive in-home, crisis response and family support services. Services are designed to assist the family with increasing safety within the home and community, as well as reducing the need for hospitalizations and out-of-home placements.
- **PARENT ADVOCATE:** Offers parent-to-parent support from someone who is familiar with parenting a challenging child and who can help the family understand and navigate through local community resources and systems.
- **RESPIRE:** Provide a needed break for the family, easing family stress and providing the child with other positive adult interaction. This day or overnight care is provided either in the home or out-of-the home by trained workers.
- **KINSHIP CARE:** Supports available for relatives caring for other family member's children.
- **VICTIM ASSISTANCE:** For children who have been the victim of abuse, provides counseling and therapy, advocacy, accompaniments, information and referrals. Services are available for recent or past victimizations.

It is a place where children can feel safe and at ease while being interviewed by a specially trained member of the CAC's multidisciplinary child abuse investigation team (MDT).

- **COMMUNITY-BASED PREVENTION PROGRAM (CBPP):** Assists children with serious emotional disturbances, provides supports to families and links families to appropriate services in the community. The goal of CBPP is to prevent out-of-home placements by providing case management support to families.

- **RESPIRE:** *provides a break, usually in a planned arrangement for at least 3 hours a week, or to aid in a situational crisis. Trained respite workers provide youth with activities in the community or on site. Activities for each child are based on a set of skills and goals set for the individual child. Workers are flexible in meeting the needs of the family, and provide care for some or all of the children in the family.*
- **TREATMENT FOR ADOLESCENTS W/ PROBLEMATIC SEXUAL BEHAVIORS:** *Adheres to a family-focused, person-centered philosophy in working with adolescents with illegal and problematic sexual behavior (PSB) and their families. Acknowledges that adolescent sexual behavior is serious, must be addressed effectively, and that adolescents have the capacity to learn to make healthier and safer choices. The program emphasizes that adolescents are most successful when they have support from adults in their lives, especially and active caregiver in the home.*
- **YOUTH CLUBHOUSE** (518)-943-2222
Provides a safe, supportive, alcohol and drug free environment for its members. Clubhouses welcome all youth 12-17 and young adults 18-21 in recovery from drugs or alcohol, or at risk of developing a substance use disorder.
